6. Consult with President and/or to the Vice-President Academic of IUSOM to ensure that the delivery of the Clinical Rotations Curriculum is consistent throughout all USA sites and delivered in a coordinated manner.
7. Foster the dissemination of information between administration, faculty, and students at all IUSOM Clinical Rotations Sites in USA.
8. Ensure that IUSOM is in compliance with all Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) Standards that relate to the clinical component of the medical students' learning environment.
