**Ref: Legalization of Character Police Reports of Mr. David Godday Onomiyede & Mr. Olusogo Tunde Olatunji in Support of their Applications for Acquiring Temporary Bonaire Residency (MVV Permit) for Enrolling in PreMed Degree Program at the International University School of Medicine (IUSOM)**

As required by Immigration and Naturalization Service (IND) Office of Bonaire Local Government in Caribbean Netherlands, in order to obtain the Legalization of their Character Police Reports in Support of their Applications for Acquiring Temporary Bonaire Residency (MVV Permit) for Enrolling in PreMed Degree Program at the International University School of Medicine (IUSOM) located in Bonaire Island, Caribbean Netherlands, recently Mr. David Godday Onomiyede & Mr. Olusogo Tunde Olatunji visited Netherlands Embassy in Nigeria. But both Mr. Onomiyede and Mr. Olatunji were informed by your office that "Netherlands Embassy in Nigeria does not legalize Character Police Reports anymore", according to both of them. Consequently, Mr. Onomiyede and Mr. Olatunji acquired the Legalization of their Character Police Reports at Nigerian Ministry of Foreign affairs and thereafter they mailed their Police Reports to IUSOM (scanned copies enclosed) via FedEx Courier.

Consequently, I tried to submit yesterday and today the Character Police Reports (legalized by Nigerian Ministry of Foreign affairs) of Mr. Onomiyede and Mr. Olatunji, to IND Office of Bonaire Local Government in Caribbean

Netherlands. But IND Office here refused to accept these 2 documents insisting that “Netherlands Embassy in Nigeria still legalizes Character Police Reports”.

Therefore, I request you please confirm to me via an E.-Mail that whether Netherlands Embassy in Nigeria still legalizes Character Police Reports or not, as soon as possible.
